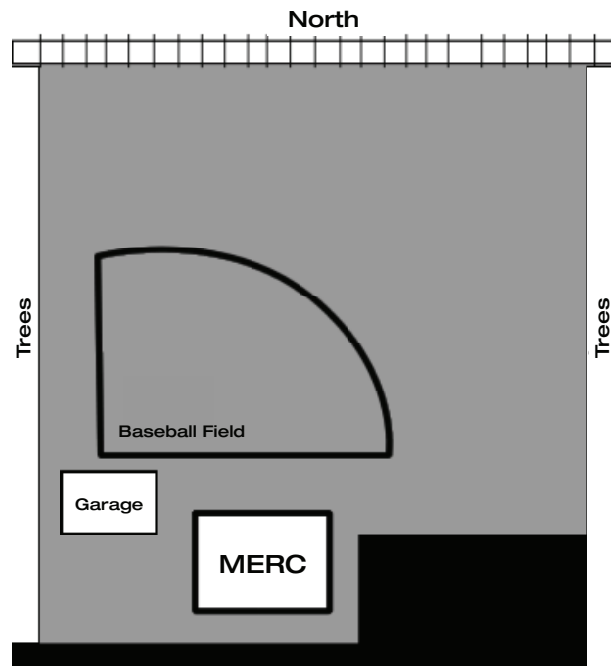

MERC Grass Cutting Tender – DEADLINE MARCH 27 2009

MERC is now accepting tenders for spring/summer grass cutting for 2009. As in the past, MERC requires that the grounds surrounding the MERC Hall be properly maintained for the summer months (from approx. April to September). Specifically, the job would require that all grass is cut, trimmed and clippings removed from around the MERC Hall, garage, baseball field and soccer fields. As well, this would include the removal of brush and garbage – including removal of garbage bags to the on-site dumpster, garbage from under bleachers and from dugouts. Special attention would also be applied to the front entrance of the MERC Hall. The full area lies between the tree lines (east and west), north to the fence line (CN property) tracks, and south to the parking lot. This is the shaded area in the picture.
